GOINGS ON ABOUT TOWN: ART

Crayola-bright colors, meandering texts, and shakily drawn lines lend the Philadelphia artist's drawings an appealingly goof-off tone. They're so deliberately casual that several have holes cut into them, framing photographs or other, smaller drawings. As a college student in 1998, Campuzano made a "movie" (really a readymade drawing) by laminating weather-forecast illustrations, cut from newspapers, and taping them together to mimic the frames of a film. Recently, he filmed the images and created an animation, which is projected in 16mm. on the wall, compressing six months' worth of wind, rain, and snow into a lightning-fast three minutes.
